This is a game for 2 players.

Materials: Fraction cards, 2 game boards

Object of the game: The first person to put 4 fractions in order from smallest to largest wins.

Set up: Place the fraction cards in a pile face down. Each player needs their own game board.

Rules: On your turn, draw a card. You can place the fraction on an empty space on the board OR switch it with a fraction that is already on the board. If you can't use the fraction card drawn you lose your turn. The first person to put 4 fractions in order from smallest to largest wins.

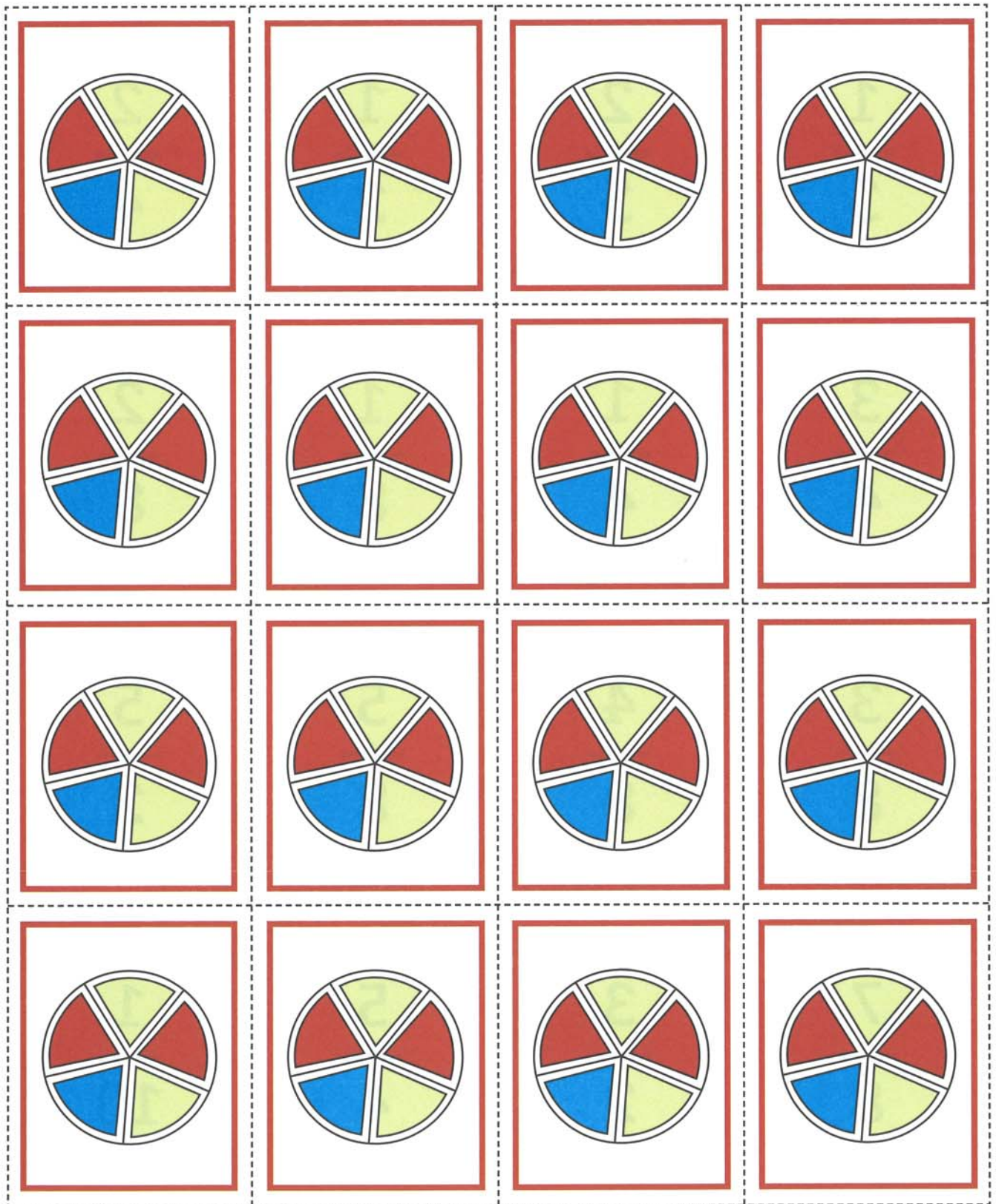
